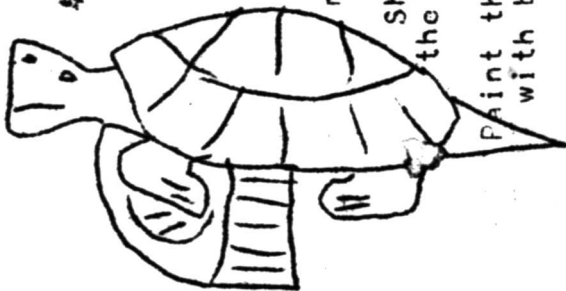


Turtle

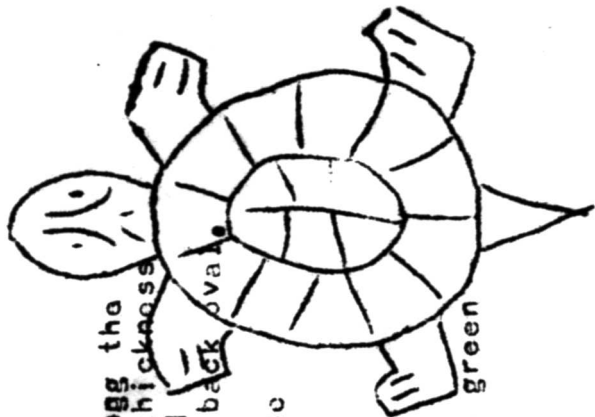


Start carving by reducing the feet to about $\frac{1}{3}$ the thickness on the blank. The head is about half. Shape the back oval.

Make slight cuts for the markings on the back.

Shape the hole and trim the bridge.

Paint the body brown, the shell green with bright markings.
