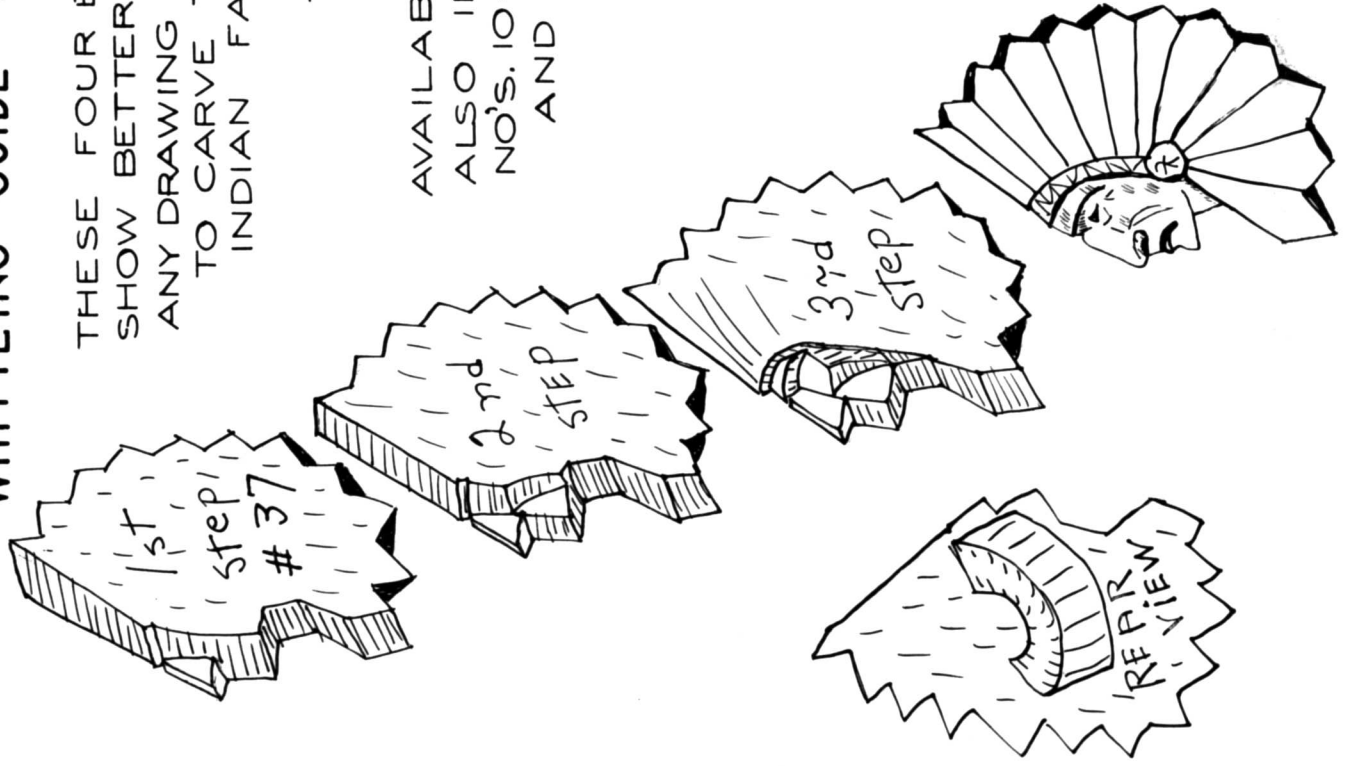

The neckerchief slide blanks are soft, knot-free, sugar pine. Provision for a hole or ring is made in the construction of all the slides. All are standard size.

## MAHOGANY

Mahogany is tougher to carve than pine, however it may be worked in finer detail and its natural color can be brought out with clear varnish, shellac or on a buff.



## WHITTILING KNIFE . . . . \$1.00

The knife illustrated is an all purpose whittling tool. It has a blade of high grade carbon steel mounted firmly in a round hardwood handle.

When properly used the blade will hold its sharp edge for a long time. It may be kept sharp by honing on a hard grained stone. To hone a knife keep the blade flat against the stone and rub with a circular motion.

The straight cutting edge is particularly suitable for whittling.
