I	/ / <b>need<u>ed.</u></b> (need-id)	/ <b>look<u>ed.</u></b> (lookt)	/ <b>play<u>ed.</u></b> (playd)	<p>Usually <u>add “-ed”</u> e.g. cook → <b>cooked</b></p> <p>* If the verb ends in -e, <u>add “d”</u>. e.g. decide → <b>decided</b></p> <p>** If the verb ends in a consonant (other than x or k), preceded by a vowel, <u>double the consonant</u>, then <u>add “-ed”</u>. e.g. drop → <b>dropped</b></p> <p>*** If the verb ends in “y”, preceded by a consonant, <u>change the “y” to “i”</u>, then <u>add “-ed”</u>. e.g. study → <b>studied</b></p>
