Possessive case

Object as Possessor

```
Formed when an object possesses an item:

The "<possessed_item>" of the "<possesser>".

Examples:

possessed possesser

The color of the pencil.

The bottons of the coat.

The end of the tape.

The window of the house.
```

Person as Possessor

When a person possesses something, the person comes first, followed by an apostrophe and s, and then immediately the object possessed:

```
examples:
```

Person as Possessor – case 2

```
If the possessor ends in s, the apostrophe is added
after the s, with no additional "s".

Examples:
    <person>s' <object>
The ladies' skirts
The boys' shoes
```
