

# sein, haben, werden (to be, to have, to become)

The three most common verbs in German have irregularities in their conjugational patterns. The conjugations for these verbs must simply be memorized.

**sein** *to be* (I am; you are, he/she/it is; we are; you are; they are)

**haben** *to have* (I have; you have, he/she/it has; we have; you have; they have)

**werden** *to become*

(I'm becoming; you're becoming, he/she/it is becoming; we're/you're/they're becoming)
