Infinitive mit 'zu' und Modalverben

Dependent Infinitives & Modal Verbs

Work on the test prep exercise sheets translating sentences from English to German using dependent infinitives. Dependent Infinitive = 'zu' + infinitive ('it's fun to, it's nice to, it's important to, in order to, instead of, without' + 'zu' + infinitive)

Mixed in with the sentences containing dependent infinitives are also modal verb constructions. Review the conjugations of the modal verbs: 'wollen, müssen, mögen'.

Remember that sentences in German with modal verbs can NOT take the dependent infinitive marker 'zu'. This is easy to confuse with English, where 'have to, want to, need to' take the infinitive marker 'to' in English. These construction in German simply take an unmarked (no 'zu') infinitive in German.
